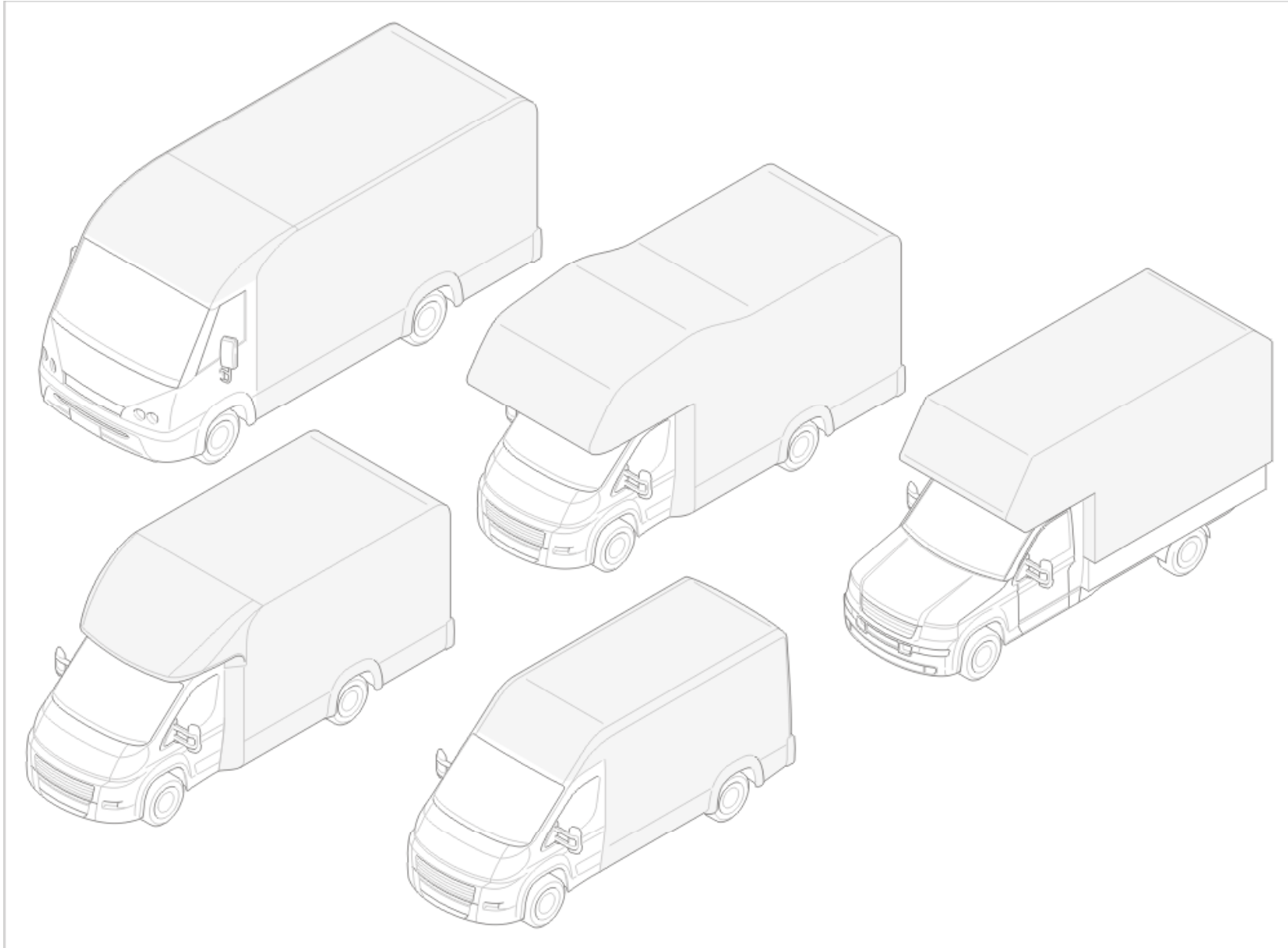

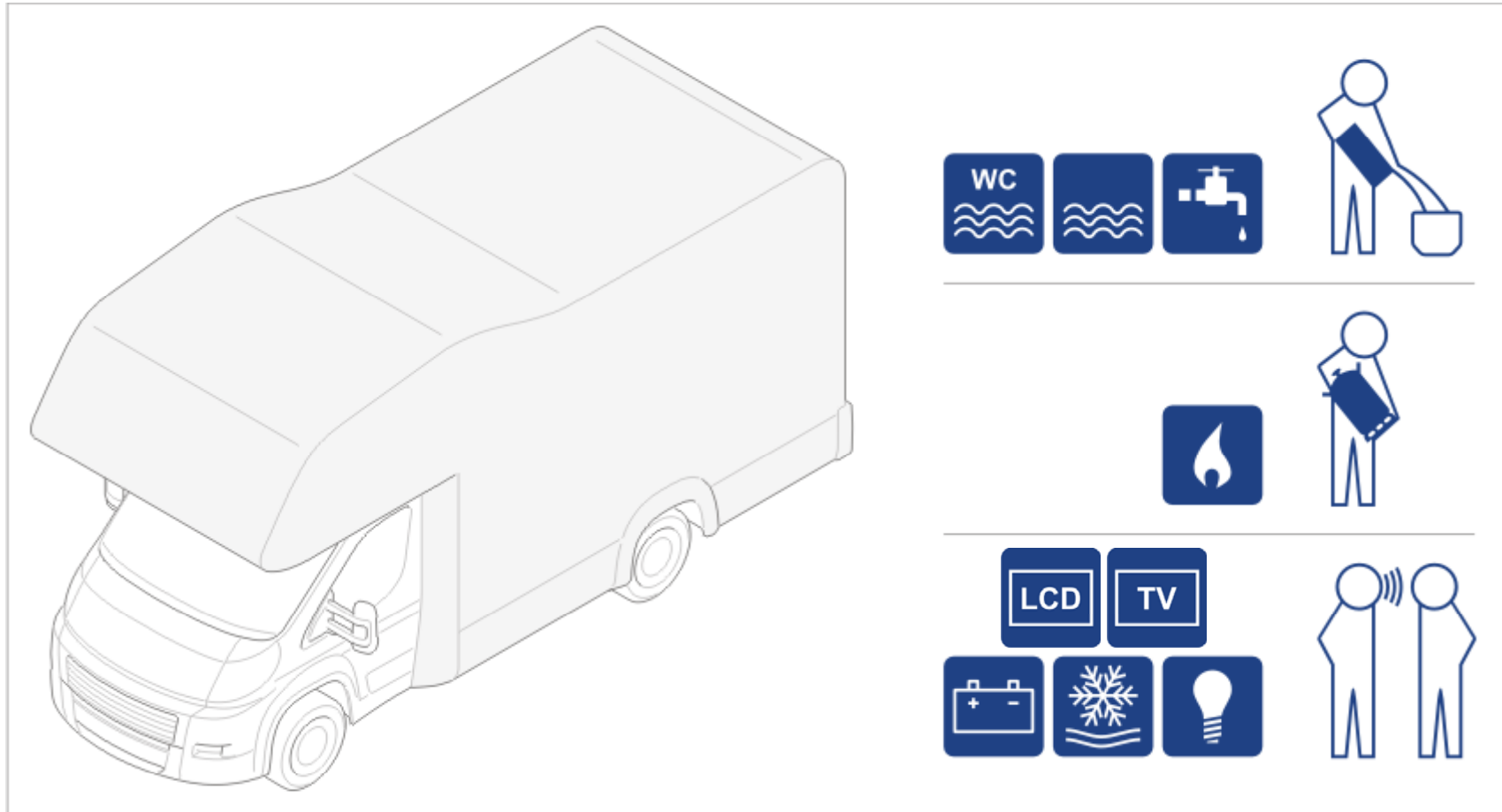
Common Information

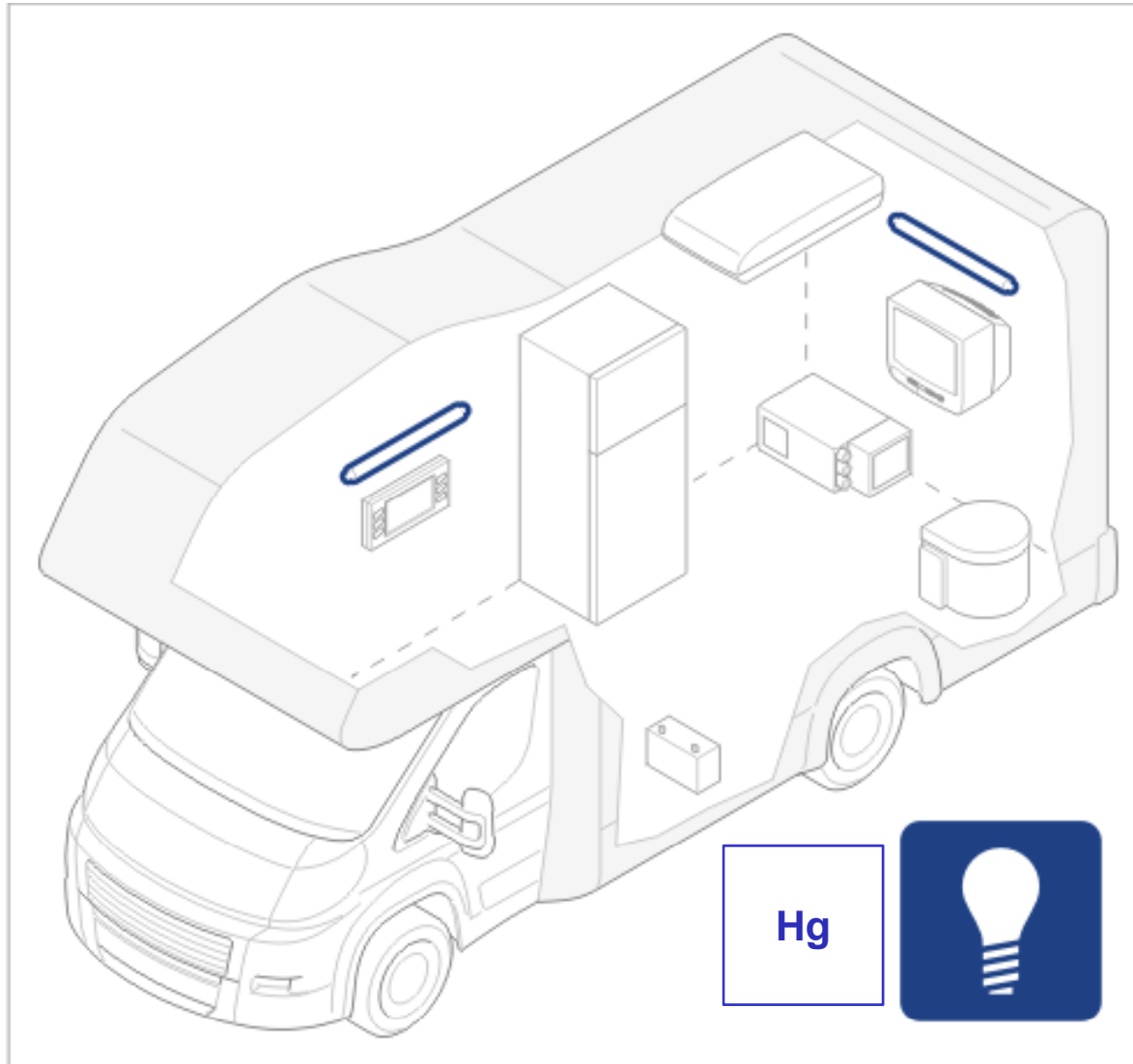
